Although polymers are part of organic coatings most of the work presented in the coatings session usually focusses on the interfacial properties of coatings and the development of new coating systems. In comparison results presented in the polymers session mainly concentrate on the application and behaviour of structural polymer materials.

To bridge the gap between people working on organic coatings on metal surfaces and those working on polymer materials, for example the following points may be addressed in the frame of this joint session during EUROCORR 2014:

- Behaviour of polymers in structural materials and in organic coatings,
- Mechanisms of corrosion protection by polymer materials bulk properties and investigation methods,
- Main influences on polymers in organic coatings and their consequences for the protective properties of organic coatings,
- Application cases and experience feedbacks,
- Inspection and monitoring techniques.
